

## Touching Little Lives

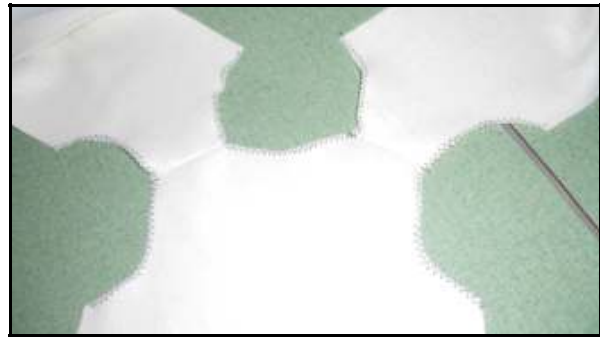
Sleep sack - step by step - picture tutorial - using regular sewing machine.



Using Polar fleece. 1/4 inch seam allowance. You can turn them in without snap/closure, we have snappy ladies that will snap them. Using a zig-zag stitch or deco stitch for top stitching. I used a dark color for this sample. No need to turn under any hem - edges as polar fleece wont fray it also avoids extra bulk. 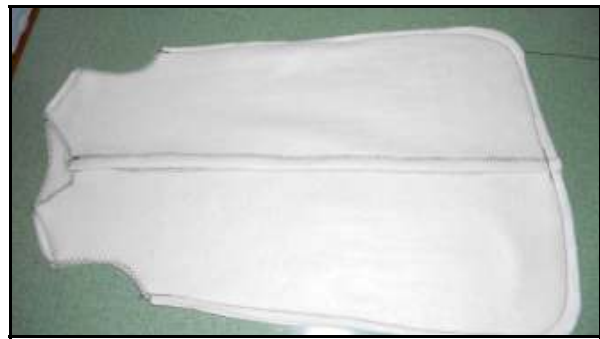
**Step: 1**  
With fabric right sides together, sew both shoulder seams. Back stitch at the beginning and end.



**Step: 2**  
Using a zig-zag or deco stitch and stitch along the neckline and arms. Do not turn fabric under.



**Step: 3**  
Top stitch both fronts from top to bottom.  
With right sides together, pin edges. Fold both fronts under so they overlap for the closure.



**Step: 4**  
Sew from one underarm all the way around to the other underarm. Using a back stitch at the beginning and end to secure edges.
